
Route:

Astrakhan (30 May) – Beyneu (31 May) – Muynak (1 June) – Khiva (2 June) – Bukhara (3-4 June) – Samarkand (5 June) – Dushanbe (6 June) – Tavildara (7 June) – Khorog (8 June) – Murghab (9 June) – Sary Mogol (10 June) – Toktogul (11 June) – Song Kul (12 June) – Bishkek (13 June)

Distance:

6,500 kilometers (4,000 miles)

The Central Asia Rally will bring together adventure enthusiasts from all over the world in Astrakhan, Russia. Once assembled, they embark on a 6,500 km trek across Central Asia in their vehicles of choice, be it a classic Lada or their brand new Land Rover, finally reaching Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan after 14 eventful days.



The Central Asia Rally is a 'minimal assistance' event with limited entry, so rather than handing all out on a plate we provide the tools and facilities participants need to find their own fun and adventure within the framework of our challenge that will have them discovering new places without spoiling the thrill of their own achievement. We won't smother or mother participants on The Central Asia Rally and if they can get to the start, and more importantly finish, they can drive anything you like from Astrakhan to Bishkek.
